## Race Series and Scoring

### Racing Setups

Race Committee, or barge crew, may set up races between 2 and 6 legs depending on wind and time constraints. All CSC Club races are counted for exception of the rust remover and for additional races attempted beyond two scheduled races for the day.

Depending on conditions and time, the race committee will be encouraged to attempt more than two races to increase the racing activity. If race committee attempts three races for the day to provide more racing, one race will be considered a throw out by each individual racer. No matter how many races occur for the day; only two races for the day will count.

### Flying Scot Scoring

There will be a Saturday and a Sunday series. Trophies will be awarded for the top finishes in each series. All races count towards the overall season championship (CSC Stern Award).

Each boat must start at least half the races to be scored. There will be a maximum of two throw outs per series, one for every five races completed on the schedule by the fleet. **Any races missed due to barge duty will be scored as the average of the six previous races raced. If there were not six previous races, then the nearest six races will be averaged.** A skipper may only do barge duty a maximum of two times. There are a maximum of 32 scored races; with Crystal Ball being excluded this year.

### Mixed Fleet Scoring

Racers in the Mixed Fleet scoring will be scored on a handicap. Awards may be available to the top three finishers depending on season participation.

### Sunfish Regatta Scoring

No throw outs, all completed races scored. Awards may be available to the top three finishers depending on race participation.

### Trophies

#### Flying Scot

There will be three trophies awarded at the end of the season for places first to third for skippers only for each series.

#### All Fleets

The Take-A-Bow award may be awarded to the sailor showing the best sportsmanship or contribution to racing.
